Additional Details

MS in Innovation & Entrepreneurship Program requires 30 credit hours (39 if all 3 Foundation Courses are needed) and is designed to be completed in one year.

Foundation Courses include: DATA 122 Elementary Statistics, ER 305 Accounting and ER 305 Marketing; these may be waived contingent upon successful completion at the undergraduate/graduate level; each student’s prior academic record in relevant business courses is reviewed by the Graduate Business Programs Office.

Classes are typically offered on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings from 6:30pm-9:15pm.

Courses may have prerequisites. Please consult course descriptions for details.

MSIE Program requires 2 Electives (6 credit hours); one global elective is recommended; sequence of Electives may vary from year-to-year.
